- Volunteers time freely and not for financial or personal gain

The Club Person of the Year Award will be determined by a majority votes received.

## Spirit of Netball

The Spirit of Netball Award is one of Kingsway Roos Netball Clubs most prestigious awards, introduced in 2020. It is awarded to someone who gives excellent service to the Club, demonstrates leadership qualities, has an ongoing commitment to the future of the Club, is a good role model for all members of the Club, and shows enthusiasm for the Club. This can be a playing member, coach, team manager or volunteer.

## Award Criteria:

- Is a role model for the club
- Puts in extra time and effort
- Helps and assists other members
- Acts in the best interest of the club
- Is an excellent ambassador for KRNC
- Volunteers time freely and not for financial or personal gain

The Spirit of Netball Award will be determined by a majority votes received. Note: An award may not necessarily be granted each year. This may be because there are no nominations received, or the Committee may deem that the nomination/s do not meet the criteria
